Offers sustainable solutions

One example of going green is by using detergent-free cleaning technology. Detergent-free cleaning can reduce labour costs by improving cleaning efficiency and eliminating the need to order, store and mix floor-cleaning chemicals before use. Some of these systems also enhance productivity by enabling crews to clean up to three times longer with a single tank of water and use up to 70 per cent less water than conventional floor cleaning equipment.

On-site generation of cleaning solutions can replace multiple conventional packaged chemicals, consolidating the number of cleaning chemicals used from half a dozen or more, to just one or two. This simplifies inventory management, employee training and cleaning processes, and reduces labour costs. Look for manufacturers that have machines certified to global and regional Green standards.

Without proper operator training or an adequate site survey, the best equipment won't enable you to perform the best cleaning possible.
