

Off-board Charger Conversion Service Kit

Models: T3e, Speed Scrub 17in/20in



This kit is intended to convert machines currently equipped with on-board chargers that may be subjected to corrosion issues with the on-board charger and/or its AC pigtail plug connection.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

Installation Time: 1 Hour

TOOLS REQUIRED: 5.5mm, 8mm socket wrench, 10mm,

1/2", 9/16" wrench, small & Large Phillips screwdriver

FOR SAFETY: Before installing kit, park machine on a level surface, turn key off and disconnect the negative (-) battery cable lead.

1. Turn key to the off position and disconnect the negative (-) battery cable lead (Figure 1).



2. Open the battery compartment and disconnect the on-board charger connector and harness wires (Figure 2).



3. Remove the on-board charger from the machine (Figure 3).




 Disassemble the charger and cover from the charger bracket as shown (Figure 4).
Discard on-board charger.



5. Re-install the charger bracket (Fig. 5).



6. Remove the rear control console panel to access the internal wiring (Figure 6).



7. Disconnect the on-board charger wire harness terminals as shown (Fig. 7).



8. Remove the on-board charger harness from the machine as shown and discard (Fig. 8).



Remove the squeegee lift bracket (Fig. 9). Two screws hold bracket in place.

10. Route the two yellow wires with open terminals from control console down through hole as shown (Figure 10).



11. Connect the two yellow wires to the roller switch as shown (Fig. 11).




12. Attach the roller switch and the charger plug harness to the squeegee lift bracket as shown (Fig. 12). Make sure the roller switch is properly adjusted before replacing the squeegee lift bracket (see Detail).





13. Route the charger plug harness up into the console as shown (Fig. 13).



14. Replace the squeegee lift bracket (Fig. 14).



15. Connect the black and red wires from the charger plug harness as shown (Fig. 15).



- 16. Reinstall the rear control console panel (Figure 6) and reconnect the negative (-) battery cable lead (Figure 1).
- 17. Discard the old 15 ft/4.5m on-board charger extension cord. Use the new 8 ft/2.5m extension cord provided with new off-board charger (Figure 16).


