NOTE: DO NOT DISCARD the Parts List from the Instruction Bulletin. Place the Parts List in the appropriate place in your machine manual for future reference. Retaining the Parts List will make it easier to reorder individual parts and will save you the cost of ordering an entire kit.

Installation Instructions for Kit number 761194

INSTALLATION OF HAZARD LABELS:




FIG. 1 - Cylinder Hazard Label Location

(Refer to Fig. 1)

1. Raise the hopper and install the cylinder stop assembly.
2. Locate the temporary hazard label on the cylinder stop assembly. Peel this label off the channel. Use isopropyl alcohol to clean any adhesive or grime that might be on the channel. Install one of the **DO NOT STORE** hazard labels (2) in the same location.
3. Use isopropyl alcohol to clean the barrel of both new hopper tilt cylinders (3). Install one **DO NOT STORE** hazard label (2) on each cylinder so it can be read from that side of the machine. (Refer to Fig. 1)
4. Locate the two **HOPPER MAY FALL** labels on the machine frame near the rear wheels. Use isopropyl alcohol to clean any adhesive or grime that might be on the frame in that area. Install one of the new **HOPPER MAY FALL** labels (1) over each of the old labels.
