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	Q:	What are the KEY dates for the S30 SweepMax® Plus transition and launch?			
1	A:	June 3	Global internal announcement (Sales Tools Available on Sales Tools Hub)		
		June 9	 Order on or before this date if a S30 needs to be delivered before end of July (will be SweepSmart™) 		
		June 10	 Global public announcement (Press Release/Website) SweepMax[®] Plus Order taking begins Note: After this date, it will be an initial 6-8 week minimum lead-time, first come, first served 		
		July 14	Production begins and first customer and demo shipments start end of week. (mix of both). Demos delivered by early August.		
	Q:	What if my customer needs S30 before end of July, and doesn't care if it's SweepMax® Plus?			
2	A:	1) Place your customers order before June 9 in order to take delivery on a S30 SweepSmart™ (legacy system) before end of July. Normal lead times apply at 3 to 4 weeks out.			
	f the customer does not need SweepMax [®] Plus but needs delivery before end o ing existing North American demo inventory SweepSmart™ machines.				
	Q:	What will the new S30 SweepMax® Plus LEAD TIME be for Customers?			
3	A:	Please work with your customers to set proper lead time expectations on this exciting new product. Estimated lead-time after June 10 will be minimum of 6-8 weeks.			
		If S30 delivery before end of July is absolutely critical, please submit the order by June 9, or consider using SweepSmart™ machines from North American demo inventory.			
	Q:	When will we be receiving S30 SweepMax® Plus demonstration units?			
4	A:	If your IMM submitted a demo order, your terriroty should receive it end of July into early August, depending on your geography. At the start of production, there will be a mix of customer and demo units being shipped.			
5	Q:	Is there a sales program for turning the base of legacy (old) sweeper models?			
	A:	Yes. Special one-time period to allow legacy sweeper models to be treated as True Trade-In models – 355, 385, 6500, 6550 – and customer can receive \$1,000 off purchase of new S30 SweepMax® Plus. Program ends November 30, 2014. Restrictions apply. More details in program guidelines which can be found on Sales Tools Hub.

	Q:	Is the S30 SweepMax [®] Plus cyclonic dust control system similar to SweepMax [®] on the S20?				
1	A: Yes, it is similar. However, it is optimized for the S30 and features many improvements over the SweepMax® cyclonic system in the S20.					
	Q:	What are the major enhancements on the new S30 SweepMax® Plus?

3	Q:	Does the S30 filter part number change with the new SweepMax® Plus system?				
	A:	Yes. The S30 filter will change and be the same filter as the S20. PN: 1045900				
4	Q:	Will there will be a wet dust control option available at launch?				
	A:	No. This option is not part of the S30 SweepMax [®] Plus program. However, we are investigating delivering this capability as a custom solution post launch. Timing is TBD.				
	Q:	Will the S30 X4 four-wheel configuration still be offered?				
5	A:	Yes. SweepMax [®] Plus does not affect X4 configuration. However, since X4 is a diesel-only machine, it will need to switch to the de-rated, 24.8 hp Kubota engine that is currently on the 3-wheel diesel models. This derated engine change does not impact transport speed, but does impact gradeability ramp climb for transport and sweeping up inclines. See new specs sheet for udpated X4 specs.

	A :	June 10 – we will also be announceing to existing customers via email – make sure your customer emails are up to date.
